ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the Dunlora Interconnect Project in Albemarle County, Virginia will be received at the office of the Executive Director, Albemarle County Service Authority (ACSA), 168 Spotnap Road, Charlottesville, Virginia 22911 until 2:00 p.m., local prevailing time, on May 17, 2016. At which time the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud.

The project includes furnishing and installing approximately 3,280 linear feet of 12-inch diameter ductile iron pipe; approximately 614 linear feet of 12-inch diameter fusible polyvinyl chloride water main; approximately 70 linear feet of 6-inch diameter ductile iron pipe and associated water interconnections, hydrants, water services, and appurtenances, and the restoration of the associated road and surface disturbed during construction.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the office of the Albemarle County Service Authority, 168 Spotnap Road, Charlottesville, Virginia 22911 at 10:00 a.m., local prevailing time, on April 27, 2016.

All bids shall be accompanied by a bid guarantee in the form of a bid bond, certified check, or cash escrow in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid.

Bidders must be Class A licensed contractors in the Commonwealth of Virginia in accordance with the requirements of Title 54.1, Chapter 11, of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended. The procedure for withdrawal of bids shall be according to Virginia Code Section 2.2-4330.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Executive Orders concerning nondiscrimination in employment and maintaining a drug free work place.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities in the bidding.
